

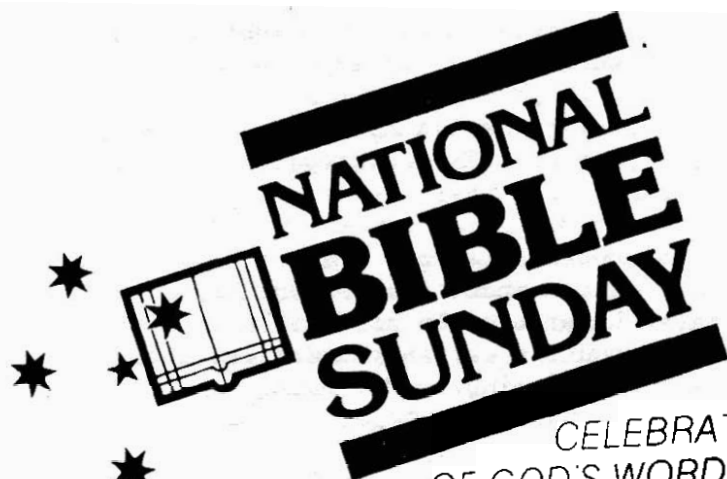

Dear Friends,

No doubt you remember that in the last issue of the CHRONICLE I outlined some new schemes which we were adopting at All Saints'. To-day I would like you to share in the success we have had so far.

Firstly, the plan to allocate our missionary giving to a named missionary society every two months. This has been a greater success than we expected.

Missionary giving over the two month period has gone up (possibly doubled). The congregation is more concerned about others and their needs. That is great.

Because we have concentrated our prayers and giving and have had information about that organization, we have a far greater understanding and interest in what is going on far beyond the parish boundaries. There are, believe me, some amazing things being accomplished by God's people.

We were able to feature our Mission for the Month in the last issue and I guess that you learnt something of the Bush Church Aid Society and its work.

In the months of July and August our attention will be directed to the Bible Society. National Bible Sunday falls on July 16th this year.

Another benefit from the planned support of various missionary societies through our freewill offertory envelopes is that members of the church not previously using the envelopes have begun to do so. This was not considered when the decision was made. It has come as an unexpected bonus.

The second scheme which I mentioned in the CHRONICLE was the Looking into the Community Workshops. These have been well attended especially by the members of the Parish Council, and they have come to all of the workshops. We planned to hold four sessions but we have now decided to hold a fifth and final workshop on July, 18th.

We are prayerful that these workshops might lead to new initiatives. We ask your prayerful support as well.

This year we have employed a theological student to work on a part time basis amongst the youth. It is pleasing to note that a Youth Fellowship operates both on Friday nights and Sunday afternoon. Young people are playing a significant role in the evening services. This is a cause for much rejoicing.

In June we held a Family Night in connection with the Sunday School. We had a varied programme of games, singing, a film and a puppet show. The Puppets and film came from the Bible Society. It was a very enjoyable evening with parents, Sunday school children, the Youth Fellowship and adult members of the congregation all joining in.

Later in the year we expect to have another Family Night in co-operation with the Church Missionary Society. This we hope will be in September.

This sounds as if it is all 'Go,Go,Go,!' at All Saints' Petersham. Yes we have made some great forward steps over the past months, but we are conscious that we still have a lot that still needs doing. In this we need above all your prayers.

Our way forward is to listen to what God is saying and to follow His lead. We need to beware of doing
