To the Registrar of Durham University

Moore College Liberia. Jan 29th 1901.

Dear Sir.

Some two years ago - I wrote to the Dean of Durham asking whether, and in what way the above College could be affiliated with your University? In reply he wrote for full particulars about the College. These I sent, but I never heard any further from him.

I now write to renew my inquiries, and would be very grateful for information on the following points

- (1) Is there any possibility - providing all things are satisfactory - of Moore College being affiliated with Durham in the same way as the C.M.S. College in Sierra Leone is? If so, under what conditions could this be brought about?
- (2) Failing that, could we be affiliated as some of the English Theological Colleges are, so that men who have passed through our course could get their degree on one year's residence at Durham?

I think I may say that the Standard of Moore College is well up to that of the home Colleges. During the last 3 years our men have sat for the English Preliminary - Out of a total of 19 entries, we have had 7 First-Classes 2 Seconds. 2 Thirds & failures; and six withdrew their names from various causes.
