THE ABOVE DECLARATION was made and subscribed before Us *William Boyd* by Divine Permission Bishop of *Ripon* — by the said *Nathaniel Jones* on his being ordained and afterwards — licensed to perform the Office of Stipendiary Curate in the *Parish Church of New Wortley* in the County of *York* within our Diocese and Jurisdiction this *nineteenth* day of *September* in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty *six* and in the *third* Year of our Consecration.
