Australia Church Women forms a network of committed Christian women, dedicated to encourage fellowship and service across denominational, national and international boundaries.

Winifred Kiek Scholarship

The offerings presented at Fellowship Day Services throughout Australia go to this scholarship, which Winifred Kiek, the first woman minister ordained in the (then) Congregational Church (now Uniting Church) in Australia, was influential in founding. The scholarship is offered to Christian women of multicultural Australia, Pacific Island nations and member countries of the Asian Church Women's Conference.
