Deaconess Alfred welcomed all present and APOLOGIES were
received from Mesdames Foster and Macintyre.

WORSHIP:

Freda Morris led in worship with thoughts on "places" and
offering prayers for Australian aborigines who are seeking
a "place" in society.

BUSINESS ARISING:

1. Mrs. Shanti Solomon has now been advised of the following

The fifth delegate whom we hope will be an aboriginal woman
is still not finalised.
2. Constitution of A.C.W.C. Suggestions for revision of the
Constitution were discussed and Rachel Cocks to be advised.
3. \$500 Investment: The Treasurer reported that the loan
had closed before she lodged the application and this would
now be held over till a new Prospectus was available.
4. Theme for 1983 Fellowship Day Service - members brought
suggestions and it was Moved F.Downes/O.Ackland that the
theme be "By the power of the Spirit our burdens are
shared". CARRIED
It was Agreed that the service be prepared in Victoria
and that the Baptist Women's Fellowship be asked to prepare
it.
5. World Community Day Service 1983: This service was the
subject of a discussion with Dr. Adair, who indicated that
U.S.A. wanted Australia to prepare this service which
would be used in both countries. Theme to be "No longer
strangers". Moved F.Morris/R.Callander that Olive Ackland
convene the committee for preparation of the Service. CARRIED
Moved F.Downes/J.Hughes that Myra Dixon and Doreen Strack
form the Committee with O.Ackland and that Deaconess Frances
be co-opted. CARRIED. McKechnie

After discussion of members' suggestions It was Agreed
that the theme for the N.C.M. be "Life as a gift from God".
This fits in with the theme of the World Council of Churches
Sixth Assembly theme "Jesus Christ, Life of the World".
