Executive had asked that His Grace the Archbishop be approached as to the possibility of the Church of England making a nomination for 1969/70.

Reports:

Finance: Mrs. Perrian reported Total balance \$287.74 made up of General Fund: \$225.81, Fellowship Least Coin \$30.77, Project Fund: \$31.16 as per audited statement. [in the absence of Mrs. Millard?] Wyhalena: Mrs. Palmer reported on the last meeting of the Wyhalena ^{Committee} and presented and tabled the audited financial statement. The balance at 18/4/68 showed invested monies \$27.600, and current account \$1,347.88.

Mrs. Montgomerie, on behalf of Mrs. Bragg who was unable to be present, asked that the Wyhalena Trust Committee consider the advisability of investing not more than \$10,000 in any one parcel.

and Council ^{asked} suggested that Mrs Bragg should send these suggestions to in writing to the Wybalena Trust Committee as this was a matter for their consideration,

As there is confusion in the minds of some members of the Executive and Council as to the terms and powers of the Trusteeship; and having regard to the concern expressed by Mrs. Ralph and others that Council may have placed the Committee in an legal position by the provision of the £100 pocket money for the Aboriginal ladies training in New Zealand, it was resolved:

"That Mrs Millar be asked to arrange for members of the Council Executive and the Wybalena Trust Committee to meet with Mr. Ian Hunt, at his convenience, to discuss the terms of the Trusteeship"

(Moved Mrs Nerve, seconded Deaconess Anderson & adopted)

Promotions: Mrs. Nerve spoke encouragingly of the increasing interest in inter church communication in local areas and mentioned

the newly formed Lane Love - Longueville group, adding her personal welcome to Mesdames McAllister and others to that of Mrs Towler. Orders of Service for Fellowship Day would be available very soon and the Promotions Committee were to meet again on May 6.

General Business:

As the Annual Meeting and this meeting had been very lengthy there was not time for further or fuller reports. Mrs Ball drew attention to the fact that this is a situation which can, and does, often occur and moved that sub-committees and representatives to various bodies with which Council is affiliated present regular brief written reports to monthly meetings. This was seconded by Mrs Ralph and unanimously adopted.

Meeting Room: Mrs Badger reported that there is a definite possibility that a room could be made available ~~from~~^{by} the Congregational Church in the near future.

Closure: Appreciation of her kindly services to ^{the} ~~the~~ Council over the past year was expressed, to Mrs Coled who had guided us through a very busy year.

There being no further business the meeting closed with the benediction.
