

## Papers of D. Broughton Knox (1916-1994)

*This is a brief list of part of the collection of Broughton Knox's papers held in the Samuel Marsden Archives. It includes personal and professional papers from the period after his retirement as Principal of Moore College, including his time as Principal of George Whitefield College in South Africa.
