REVEREND SIR,

The Most Reverend the Archbishop of Sydney having been pleased to appoint you to the office of Surrogate for granting Episcopal Licenses of Marriage within his Diocese; I beg leave to forward blank forms of Application and Declaration to be made preparatory to the granting of such Licenses, which you will be pleased to have *carefully* completed and transmitted to this office from time to time *at the earliest opportunity* after their date.

Marriages must on all occasions be solemnized in the Church or place where Divine Service is usually held, unless under special circumstances, to be stated in an application to the Archbishop for permission to perform the ceremony elsewhere.

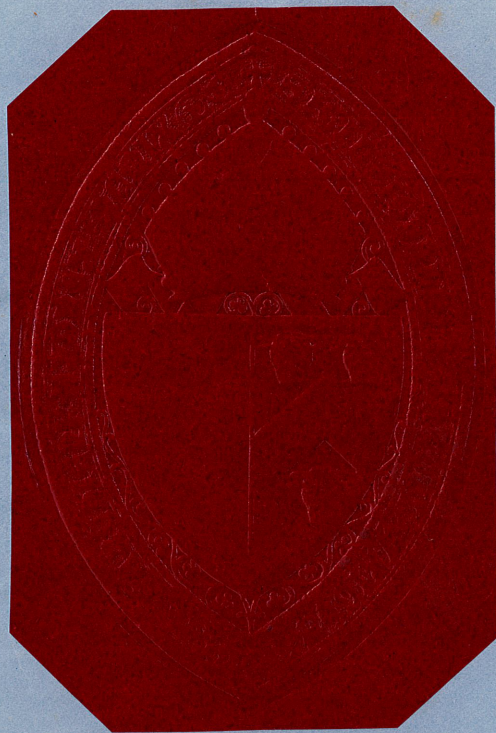
