I am sorry I could
not send it in time

for the birthday which I think
is Oct 17. however it will
not be much after so better
late than never give my
love to her and tell I hope she
will marry wisely or remain
single to comfort her old dad
like my Senny, who with her
aunt Mary & Sarah have have
returned from Rhyll much
improved in health; I
cannot yet find out whether
she ^(Mary) is going to keep on the
farm but I should think
not unless she can get a good
husband to help her.

Senny returned in time
for Mr Brown's Harvest home
all the rest of us have left him
Willie Thomas preached the
harvest sermon at Trinity on
Sunday week; I am sending
you a portrait of his old mother

cut out of the Quiver
Magazine a volume
of which I bought for John
when I returned from Rhyl
it seems he is still in
harness, but Evangelism
is woefully out of date
an ex vicar on the sands
