

AUSTRALIAN CHURCH WOMEN

ACW celebrated its Golden Jubilee in 1988. On November, 1938, women of the Churches of Christ, Presbyterian, Congregational and Methodist denominations came together in St. Stephen's Church, Sydney, and formed the WOMEN'S INTER- CHURCH COUNCIL.

This group was joined by women from the Baptist (1953), Salvation Army (1955), Anglican (1958), Roman Catholic (1969) and Ukrainian Orthodox (1992) denominations. In 1963, the name was changed to AUSTRALIAN CHURCH WOMEN.

Special Days of Celebration are:

FELLOWSHIP DAY - last Friday (when possible) in July.

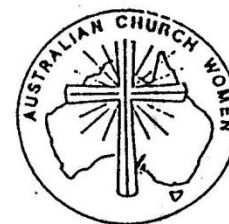
WORLD COMMUNITY DAY - last Friday (when possible) in October.

SPIRITUAL ENRICHMENT DAY - days of spiritual inspiration and challenge (dates arranged).

Special Projects are:

Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC). Supports women-oriented projects around the world as a practical expression of prayer fellowship.

Winifred Kiek Scholarship (WKS). Enables a Christian woman, annually, from the Asian, Indian or Pacific region to undertake supplementary study for up to 10 months as an addition to basic training in her chosen field of Christian service.
