Introduction

The correspondence, diaries and memoirs of Henry Crabb Robinson, as is well known, form part of the Dr. Williams's Library collection of manuscripts. In 1938 Professor Edith Morley printed a valuable index to as much of the correspondence as concerned her purpose in writing *Henry Crabb Robinson on books and their writers*, 3 vols, Dent, 1938. It may not be realised by readers of that work that letters are preserved of many others with whom Crabb Robinson corresponded whose names do not appear in Miss Morley's index. Regarded as an index of the correspondence as a whole it is incomplete.

The purpose of the present index is to make good the omissions. It would have been attractive to print a complete index, but reasons of economy ruled that the present index should be a supplement to Professor Morley's, designed to include all that she excluded. Anyone wishing to consult a complete index must therefore go to the small extra trouble of consulting both Professor Morley's index and this supplement.

The index itself follows the general plan laid down in Miss Morley's work. Each letter is indicated by the year, followed by the serial number of the letter in the volume covering that year or by the location mark of the "bundle" in which it will be found.

The vast majority of letters are those received by Robinson from the correspondents under whose names they appear. Where this is not the case the necessary information is given before the year date in round brackets, as follows:—

- (1) (from H.C.R.) = a letter (or copy of a letter) from Robinson to the correspondent under whose name it appears.
- (2) (to M.N.) = a letter from the correspondent named to M.N.
- (3) (from M.N.) = a letter from M.N. to the correspondent named.

Because of the large number of letters involved in close sequence over a number of years, correspondence with Crabb Robinson's own family is not entered in detail, nor are details given in the case of some other very frequent correspondents, but the names appear in the index and the space of years over which the frequent correspondence took place is given.

Full details may be consulted in the index kept at the Library. Letters to Thomas Robinson, not from his brother, but from other correspondents are entered under those correspondents in round brackets thus (to T.R.).

Some corrections and additions to Professor Morley's index have been included in this supplement, especially where cross-references have been omitted in the earlier work. Some names of correspondents will therefore be found both in her index and in this supplement. References to Miss Morley's *Henry Crabb Robinson on books and their writers* are made under the abbreviation M:BW.
