HYMN

LEADER Together we meet . . .

What does it mean to meet? People meet by chance or on purpose with joy, with fear, with hope. Though they meet, they may be so far apart, neutral or hostile, that they do not meet at all. Then there is cause for sorrow. Sometimes, when they meet, they discover each other, so that the eyes are opened and the hearts touched, and they bring dignity and grace to each other.

What do we look for in our meeting?

ALL Oh God, we begin to see how often we have refused to meet people, refused to trust ourselves to them. We have been insensitive and thoughtless. We have been proud or afraid. We ask you, through them, to forgive us.

LEADER Together we meet before God . . .
As people of faith, we recognize another dimension to our meeting. When we gather in the name of God, He is among us in His holiness and power.
How shall we understand this meeting?

ALL Open our eyes, O God, to your glory, that we may worship in spirit and in truth, and offer you the praise of glad and thankful hearts.

LEADER Together we meet before God to hear His voice . . .
As Moses and the children of Israel came to the tent of meeting before the Lord, and knew His promise that He would speak with them and sanctify the meeting with His glory, so we stand in His presence and await His word,
What will be the word of the Lord?
Shall we hear it or shall we refuse to hear it?

ALL We begin to see how we have refused to meet you, O Lord.
We have been afraid to let your word enter our hearts.
We have been afraid that you would ask of us more than we wanted to give.
Lord, we are sorry. We ask you to forgive us.

LEADER We ask that in this meeting God will help us to hear and to understand, to see and to perceive.

ALL Meet and speak with us, O God, and teach us to desire what you desire for us and for all whom we meet. Give us wisdom and courage, and let us not be weary in doing your will, through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord.

LEADER We open our minds to hear the Word of God.

LEADER Lord, share out among us the tongues of your Spirit, that we may burn with compassion for all who hunger for freedom and humanness; that we may be doers of the Word and so speak with credibility about the wonderful things you have done.

ALL Lord, direct us in ways we do not yet understand, and equip us for the service of reconciliation and liberation in your world.

Indonesian Council of Churches Transmigration Training Program

Java and Bali are two very densely populated islands in Indonesia. Since other Indonesian islands are sparsely populated, and could support many more people, the Indonesian Government has undertaken a program of transmigration — or moving people to places where they can support themselves and their families and achieve an acceptable standard of living.

Indonesian Christians are amongst the families willing to be transmigrated and the Indonesian Council of Churches is providing a training program prior to migration, which will help settlers adjust to their new life. Prior to departure families are given basic training in agriculture, animal husbandry, carpentry and basic skills.

This year's World Community Day Offering will be used to help the Indonesian Council of Churches carry out this program.

FELLOWSHIP OF THE LEAST COIN — The money given to this fund goes to assist projects as designated by the Asian Church Women's Conference, the administering body.

This World Community Day Service has been prepared for Australian Church Women by Rachel Cocks, A.C.W. delegate to the Asian Church Women's Conference, who attended the Asian Church Women's Seminar in the Philippines, June, 1976. Assistance was given by Rev. John May, of Hobart.
