

The 'Festival of Light' was launched in September 1971 with the first peaceful 'demonstration' by the 'silent majority' in Trafalgar Square, London, with 35,000 persons led by **Malcolm Muggeridge, Mary Whitehouse, Sir Cyril Black** and other British leaders. Over 225,000 shared in similar open air rallies across the U.K. and 1.3 million people signed a national petition.



In 1975 the F.O.L. organised an Australia-wide concert tour by **Pat Boone and family**.



Malcolm Muggeridge challenged over 35,000 at the F.O.L. Family Celebration in Hyde Park on 10th October 1976.

The Australian Festival of Light Campaign was launched in 1973 with a series of rallies throughout Australia which were led by **Mary Whitehouse**. On April 7, 1974, over 35,000 persons shared in a massive F.O.L. rally in Hyde Park. **Speakers included Archbishop Sir Marcus Loane, Cardinal Sir James Freeman, Rev. Alan Walker, Dr. John Court and Dr. Clair Isbister.**
