



The Family of God.

The Church is the Family of God, the company of men and women who have placed their faith and trust in Jesus Christ and have therefore become members of God's Family. the Gospel of St. John, Chapter 1 and verse 12 has these words "as many as received Him (i.e Jesus Christ) to them gave He power to become the Sons of God".

The Church is no mere human instrument created by man and under his control. The Church is a Divine Organism created by God and under the direction of His Holy Spirit. Every Christian is therefore a member of God's Family, the Divine Organism which God has created to carry on His work in the world. Every Christian is called upon to enjoy the privileges and to accept the responsibilities which membership in God's Family implies.

The Bible knows nothing of "Solitary Christianity", of a man or woman endeavouring to live a Christian life in their own way. The Family of God only becomes a effective unit as each Christian takes his place in the Family circle and assumes his share of the Family Responsibility.

The Church being the Family of God is called upon, to represent Jesus Christ to the world ... to set forth the standards which He exemplified and to call all men to receive the salvation which He purchased by His Death on Calvary.

You and I (if we have not already done so) can become effective members of the Family of God by linking ourselves with the Church, partaking of the Family Fellowship and sharing in the Family Responsibilities.

One Christian who absents himself from worship in God's House and from the Fellowship of God's people weakens the life of the whole family and so hinders the extension of the Kingdom of God.
