BASED ON THE LORD'S PRAYER

Which should be said slowly and thoughtfully
at the close of each day's prayers

NOTE: Individuals, rulers, clergy, parents, friends, and others, should be remembered by name when possible, wherever the words suggest their duties or their needs. Room is left in each day's prayers for names to be inserted under the heading "Especially."

NOTE CAREFULLY

These lines of prayer and praise are meant to be read slowly and thoughtfully, with pauses and recollections, and with remembrance of others where it should be made.

Sunday

I laid me down and slept and rose up again for the
Lord sustained me: Thanks be to God.

my world.

Bishops, Clergy and people that through their life
and witness and worship

The faithful may find salvation, and the careless
be awakened:

The doubting may find faith and the anxious find
hope,

The tempted may find help and the sorrowful
comfort,

The weary find strength and the strong renewal,
The aged find consolation and the young inspiration,
And Thy peace be upon us all.

On going to Holy Communion:

As watchmen wait for the morning, so do we
wait for Thee, O Christ, come to us with the dawn-

generous.

Help us to share with all who need, help us to care
and to work that all may have good homes, good
clothing and good food, and opportunity to work
and to serve.
