THE ARCHBISHOP OF SYDNEY

TO BE READ IN THE CHURCHES ON  
EASTER DAY.

Brethren in Christ,

As we rejoice in the fact commemorated on Easter Day, let me remind you, as members of the Church, of our spiritual responsibility towards the men and women who are ready to give their lives for us. I most gratefully acknowledge the splendid support given by Church people to the Church of England National Emergency Fund, and on this Day, when so many of you are gathered together, I make a further appeal for your continued assistance. We have to maintain what we have begun; there are additional Huts to be built in Camps; there is still financial indebtedness on the efforts already made.

A pamphlet giving details of the work of C.E.N.E.F. is available at the Church door. I invite every member of the congregation to take a copy and read it. As a result, I trust there will be a generous response from your parish on Anzac Sunday.

We could well make the response to this Appeal a thank-offering for the many mercies God has bestowed upon us during this last year.
