Read the Common Prayers, and Perform all other Ministerial Duties belonging to the Office of a *Priest* of the
Church of England in the *Districts served from Perry Hall in the Archdeaconry of Sandhurst* within our Diocese
and Jurisdiction, on the nomination of *The Venerable John Christian MacCullagh, Archdeacon
of Sandhurst* according to the form prescribed in the Book of Common Prayer of the Church of
England, and not otherwise, or in any other manner, you having first before us taken the Oaths and made and subscribed
the Declaration which in this case are required by Law to be taken, made, and subscribed; reserving to us and our successors
the power to revoke at pleasure this License and Authority.

In Witness whereof we have caused our Episcopal Seal to be affixed to
these presents this *Eleventh* day of *December* in
the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Ninety *five*
and in the *ninth* Year of our Consecration.
