

Stephen Taylor B.A. who united "Australian birth to English University Education" - came to the Diocese in 1898, young, scholarly and a town man, adapting himself to bush conditions, he was loved by the country folk of Gresford and Paterson, as well as later by the city folk of St. John's Newcastle; he resigned from the latter in 1910 to go to Erskinville in the Diocese of Sydney; he had "made his way" on to a number of Synod Committees, being particularly enthusiastic in the cause of "Foreign " Missions.
