## 120th ANNIVERSARY 28th July 1991

On Sunday, 28th July 1991 we celebrated the 120th Anniversary of the Laying of the Foundation Stone of St Paul's Church, Burwood. The Celebration Committee comprising the Rector, Tony Balleine, Keith Lane, Frank Coe, Barry Brandy, Lorna Whitley and Moya Holle had arranged that we celebrate the day in two ways. It was a fine, sunny but crisp winter's day.

The first celebration was in the lovely church designed by Edmund Blacket. A congregation of about 300 people gathered to give praise and thanksgiving to God as St Paul's Changeringers rang a 1/4 Peal to honour the event. The Liturgical Service was Morning Prayer conducted by the Rector; with hymns of praise led by Noelene Weatherby-Fell on the Rogers Organ and the 20 piece New Continental Chamber Orchestra conducted by Daniel Yi Sun. St Paul's Singers gave a lovely rendition of Mozart's "Ave Verum" with Organ and Orchestra. The Lessons were read by Moya Holle, Barry Brandy and Peter Bass. The Intercessory Prayers were led by Tony Balleine. Bishop Sir John Grindrod preached the Sermon on the significance of St Paul's Burwood on the lives of its worshippers over 120 years. He emphasised Joy and Worship, Service from the Temple, and the Church was for all nations. At the end of the Sermon, a Memorial Plaque was dedicated in Memory of Lionel Kenneth Lucas who had been a faithful parishioner and also a missionary in Papua New Guinea for 33 years. His sister Eileen was present with her husband Arnold, as were other members of the family and also a number of his former friends who were Comrades of St George. The Service concluded with a Procession while we sang the hymn, "Praise to the Lord", while the Bells rang out, a peal of praise.

The Servers for the Service were Graham Stillwell, Emma Stapleton, Greg Stewart and Katie Stewart. We were pleased to have a number of Civil Dignitaries and special guests present including Sister Faith representing the Sister of the Church; and Dr Bob Woods, MP for Lowe; Paul Zammit MP for Strathfield; Rita Zammit; Geoff Howe, Mayor of Burwood; Janet Howe, Peggy Brown and Alistair Moss, Burwood Councillors. Also present were the Revd Graham Harrison, Rector of St Thomas', Enfield and the Revd James Pettigrew, Rector of St Luke's, Concord.

The second part of the Celebration followed with a Luncheon in the Parish Hall arranged by the Catering Committee, Louis Balleine, Sue Hall, John Hall, Moya Holle, Sue Balasingham and Joy Brandy. The floral arrangements were done by Jean Miller and Ruth Hogan. The Parish Hall and the Luncheon had been prepared on Saturday evening and on Sunday morning before the Church Service. About 150 guests sat down to a Luncheon of Chicken and Ham Salad followed by Fruit Salad and an Anniversary Cake. Name badges were worn by most who were present. Many of them had been hand printed by Kathy Coupland.

The official guests were Bishop Sir John Grindrod, Lady Del Grindrod, Alderman Peggy Brown and Alderman Alistair Moss who deputised for the Mayor of Burwood. Apologies were received from a number of people including the Archbishop of Sydney. Mr Greg Stewart, a Parish Councillor was Master of Ceremonies. Bishop John said the grace and Churchwarden Keith Lane proposed the Royal Toast. Alderman Moss spoke of the influence of St Paul's has in the community and he was supported by Alderman Brown. Tony Balleine made a delightful speech on what it must have been like on 29th July 1871. The Rector and Moya Holle gave thanks to all who had participated and made the day's event possible.

The finale came with the cutting of the Anniversary Cake by Kath Grant, Prasad Balasingham and Michelle Brock while everyone present sang the Doxology. The Celebration was a memorable occasion in which we all gave thanks to God for our founders and their vision for St Paul's, a vision we have worked to realise under God over 120 years and pass that vision on to others who will follow in the years to come. Our thanks to the Committees whose hard work under God brought good success, on the day.
