too wet. I had also to get
new top sails as the ones I
got first would not do.
It took me a whole day
too get them as they are
very scarce. A tree fell
across the telephone wire

and it was Tuesday before they
got it fixed. Every thing is
not so bad as I thought it
would be & I hope if this dry
wind two more rain to
get things ship shape again.
I would like to know the
day before you & Mr. Jones
are coming up to as to be
able to have fires in sitting
& bed room. This is the first
day I have had dry feet for
a week.
