Following her marriage in January 1972, Lynette served with Ken in a number of corps in Queensland and New South Wales before being appointed to The Salvation Army's work in Pakistan where they served for four years. Subsequent overseas appointments included four years in Seoul, South Korea and three years at International Headquarters in London, plus short periods relieving in Chisinau, Moldova and in Taiwan.

Her first involvement with Australian Church Women was with the Southport, Queensland branch between 1973 and 1975. She was a member of the ACT Unit 1979-1981. Lynette served as The Salvation Army's representative on National Council of Women NSW and ACT, and the NSW Council of Churches. Lynette served as President on the ACW National Executive 2013-2015.
