Dear Friends,

One of the Old Testament prophets lamented the fact that the people of his day had no foundation to their lives. One could be forgiven for thinking that the prophet could well be speaking about our own generation. We see this same thing happening to-day.

The catch-cry of many people to-day is 'If you want it have it.' It doesn't matter how you get it or who you hurt in the process, the mere fact that you want it is sufficient to justify what you do. It is the law of th jungle, the survival of the fittest.

What happens when the conquest turns sour, or the thing gained brings unpleasant side issues? Even worse what if a stronger and more ruthless contender snatches the prize away?

Too often the answer is seen in the suicide rate, the drug scene or the mental hospital.

When people without a foundation or standard in life seek a way out, where do they start? They have no absolute standard, no place to begin. It is a hopeless state to be in.

Many to-day are still very happy to laugh at the old fashion standards suggested to us in the Bible. Fancy suggesting one husband one wife. What! no affairs? How mid-Victorian! Worse still, fancy always being

truthful! How dangerous! Not to steal? Well, that could affect our Tax Returns and our fares on Public Transport, ect., etc.

These however are the standards given to us by God our Creator. These are the standards which we find in the Bible. They are the basis upon which Christians live their lives and to which they return again and again. Yes! Christians do stray from these God given standards but they have a point to which they can return. That point is God's Word-THE BIBLE.
