

AUSTRALIAN CHURCH WOMEN

Australian Church Women was established in 1965 when women's interchurch councils from all states and territories came together to form Australian Church Women, fostering ecumenism and undertaking action on behalf of the churches.

Australian Church Women forms a network of committed Christian women dedicated to encourage fellowship and service across denominational, national and international boundaries.

Fellowship of the Least Coin – Monies which have been collected with prayers for peace, justice and reconciliation during the past year are brought to World Community Day services by groups and individuals and are dedicated.

The *General Offering* from this service is to be divided between *Asian Church Women's Conference*, with which Australian Church Women is affiliated and supports annually, and the **2009 Special Project** which is '**Kairos Outside**' Perth. This is a weekend for women who may have a loved one in prison, or been in prison themselves. During the weekend this support is provided in a safe environment with Christian people and the chance to interact with other women who are in similar situations.

All: *May we live the fulfilment of our prayers.*


