

Minutes of a Meeting of N.S.W. W.I.C.C. held at Central Baptist Church, George St. Sydney on Friday 25th June, 1971 at 10.30 AM

Deaconess Mary Andrews: She gave us a brief,
but most interesting summary of her recent visit
to Wichita, & brought us the exciting news that
for the first time a Black Woman - Mrs Harvey was
President of C.W.I. (Christian Women United)

Minutes of the April Council meeting were
then read & confirmed.

Business Arising:

- 1) It was moved Mrs Wills seconded Mrs Cowled that records of 1970 Annual meeting be typed & confirmed at the August Council meeting.
- 2) The change of date of further meetings, details were not yet completed & this was deferred to a later date.
- 3) Mrs Dougherty read the report from Solicitor, copies would be made available to members for future reference.
- 4) Deaconess Andrews moved on behalf of members expression of thanks to Mrs Dougherty for her loyalty & integrity during the Wybella case.
- 5) General Information: Mrs Wills reported that no definite plans had been made to date, but Mrs Coates would keep us informed.
- 6) ^{RALLY} Mrs Carpenter expressed thanks to all who helped make the Annual Rally the success it was & Mrs Green moved & Mrs Speffer seconded that a letter of appreciation be sent to Major Mr Lachlan (this has been done.)

- (2) Calendar Diaries: Mrs Carpenter asked Council to consider purchasing these & pointed out the

advantages & value publicity wise, & the opportunity for doing something practical to bring in finance & so aid the promotion of the Winnipeg Kirk Scholarship fund. Mrs Johnson moved & Mrs Pfeffer seconded that a letter be sent to the Working Committee in the affirmative.

Social Issues Officer: Mrs. Hartshope was nominated for this position, mainly to watch the Teenagers magazine "Dolly" & other literature for any contentious segments.

Members were asked to report at next council meeting the materials that were out. e.g. pens, notebooks, books etc for stock taking purposes.

It was moved that Council ratifies the purchase of the summing up of the Wyatina case at a cost of \$13. & that a letter be sent to Mr. ~~Spickett~~ ^{Debrett} thanking him for his assistance & for balance.

A request from Rev. Sprackett for ladies to assist in tea making etc at G.E.N.G. House on Wednesday 7th July at 5. p.m.

Plans for August Council meeting were discussed & it was decided to hold International discussion groups. Members were asked to make this known to their own groups, & a basket luck be brought, & a cup of tea provided.

The meeting closed with the Lord's prayer & benediction at 12.30 P.M.
