MEMORIAL MINUTE TO MRS. RUBY McCALLUM

We record our appreciation of the life and work of Mrs. Ruby McCallum, foundation member of this Council, who passed away on 20th November 1965.

Mrs. McCallum was a Past President of the Inter-Church Council, an early chairwoman of the Committee set up to establish "Wybalena" Hostel, a member of the National Missionary Council, and from 1946-1952 was Travelling Secretary of the Women's Conference of the Churches of Christ. From 1954-1957 she was matron of "Wybalena".

Born in Victoria, married to Rev. McCallum in Tasmania, she and her husband spent some years in Canada and U.S.A., returning finally to the Church of Christ at Epping in 1939, where Mr. McCallum died in 1944.

Her family of three survive her - namely Mrs. Joy Flattman in Victoria, Dr. Elsie-May now Mrs. Ashton-Martin of Sydney and the Rev. Hayden McCallum, now Professor in a Theological College in U.S.A.

Mrs. McCallum had gifts of leadership and a winsome and friendly disposition which enhanced her Christian service.

We thank God on every remembrance of Ruby McCallum and commend to our Heavenly Father her family who cared so lovingly for her in her latter days of failing strength.
