Dear Nathaniel

I am writing to tell
you we have gone Father
laid up again but has
had another attack something
like the last one only not
quite so bad but he seems
weaker and has been in bed
a week Doctor Beesford says
it is something approaching
apoplexy but his heart is
very weak and if he walks
from the bed to the fire he
can hardly get his breath
he looks very thin and bad.
Doctor says he must be very
careful and keep as quiet as
he can

I hope you are all well
and that you have spent
a very happy Christmas
I suppose you have spent
it at your new place this
time I hope you still like the
change. We have spent a
very quiet one Mary and Charles
came on Christmas day in the
evening they are all well
Uncle Thomas and Aunt Fanny
called here to day they both
look very well

Mother has been called away
so I must finish this or it
will not be in time for the
post. Charles has been buying
property. he has bought The
Fords Farm near Wootton
where Mr Davies used to live
It is 117 acres, they say it is

very good land, the house is very roomy only
rather old fashioned, I don't know if he
intends going there to live, very likely they
will in a few years time.

We all join in love to you all wishing you
all a happy and prosperous New Year
