**Ascension Day, Thursday 13th May.**—There will be three Services at the Parish Church on this day, viz.: 7.30 a.m. Holy Communion, 11 a.m. Mattins and Holy Communion, and 8 p.m. Choral Evensong. The Church observance of Ascension Day is becoming again, after a long period of carelessness, more and more general. The fact of it falling on a week-day, as it must always do, makes it impossible for some and difficult for many, to attend the Services of the Church; but it is worth while making a serious effort to be, if possible, at the Holy Communion on the day of our Lord's Ascension into Heaven, and to help to make the other Services as worthy of the Festival as we can.

**Whit-Sunday, 23rd May.**—Special Services on this great Festival in honour of the Holy Spirit and the Birthday of the Church will be held in both Churches. There will be two Celebrations of Holy Communion at the Parish Church: at 7.45 and 11 a.m., and at St. Augustine's Church at 11 a.m.; Services for the young at 3.15 p.m., and Choral Evensong in each Church at 7.15 p.m.

**Trinity Sunday, 30th May.**—Special Sermons will be preached, and Collections made on behalf of the Home Mission Society, which undertakes the assistance of poor parishes and the extension of Church work in our diocese.

**Presentation to Rev. W. T. Prentice.**—ST. AUGUSTINE'S.—After the Service on Thursday evening, April 22nd, the Choir and a few friends of St. Augustine's Church presented the Rev. W. T. Prentice with a gold watch suitably inscribed as a token of their esteem. Messrs. N. McLeod, H. G. Norman, T. Coucom, C. H. Mailey and A. J. Spooner spoke in appreciative terms of the good work accomplished by him, and Mr. H. Evans made the presentation in a few well-chosen words wishing him and Mrs. Prentice good health and hoping they would remain amongst us for some time to come. Rev. W. T. Prentice suitably responded.

**The Easter Vestry Meetings** were duly held at both Churches; the accounts passed, and officers elected for the ensuing year, and the customary votes of thanks carried with acclaim. This issue is so fully occupied with annual accounts and lists of subscribers that there is no space left for comment on these important gatherings except to ask for the newly-elected officers the cordial co-operation and liberal support of their fellow-Churchmen.

**All Saints' Church Fence.**—His Grace the Archbishop has kindly arranged to pay a visit to the Parish on Saturday 5th June for the purpose of dedicating the memorials contained in the new iron gates and stone piers and brick wall and children's gate on the Stanmore-Road frontage. The Ceremony will begin at 3.15. We give this notice thus early in hope that parishioners will take note of the date and keep that afternoon free from other engagements.

**The Diocesan Festival** of the Home Mission Society will be held in the Sydney Town Hall on Tuesday 18th May. Tickets (one-shilling each) may be had from the District Visitors or obtained at the Church doors.

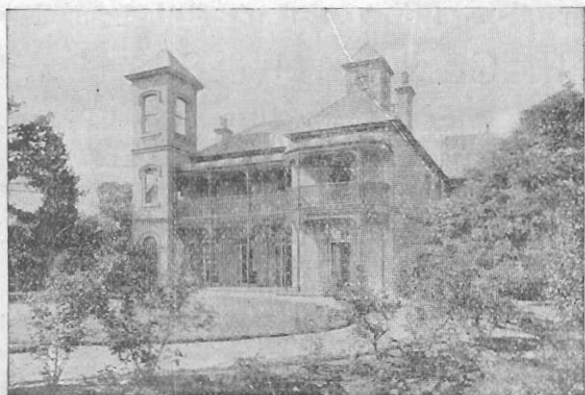
