

Th^o it was ^{g^d} equal to it, yet in his
meditation^a capacity he acted as his Father's
messenger, or servant - The Father sent his
Son as our text expresses it -

1st made of a woman - This Expression
would have been superfluous if applied to
any mere man, but as applied to J^h J^{es}
it is of great Importance. Our adorable
S^{on} was not born like other men, but
was born in the womb of a pure
Virgin by the operation of the Holy Ghost
and this was necessary on many Accounts
J^h had been born in the ordinary way
of Generation, he w^d have been comprehended
in Adam's national Prosperity, and w^d therefore
have been involved in the same Curse
as all other men are on Account of the
first Transgression -

In Adam all died, and thro his Disobedience
all were made sinners, even all who
were represented by him as their Governor
Head - moreover he w^d have been corrupt
for who can be but not deriving his Existence
from man, he could not be reached among
the Sons of Adam, and being born by
the immediate Agency of the Holy Spirit
he was perfectly holy without Spot -
This miraculous ^{mode} of Conception and Birth
was further necessary, in order to fulfil
the Prophecies: for in the very first
Promise, that intimated Gods of renewed
Intention to the C^d it was said the
Seed of L^d It had afterwards been more
plainly declared, if a Virgin sh^d conceive
L^d Hence the Prophecy in the last
marks at once, if L^d was ^{Christ} fitted for

their Character or Situation may be
The Kingdom of Jesus will be rewarded
for all Acts of Kindness that he has shew

to his fellow creatures - for the Judge
 & all will view every man according
 to his works, and the motives from
 which they proceeded -
 Gov. Lathrop also told us what sentence
 he will pass upon the ~~condemned~~, and how
 and why - Deputys censured into
 everlasting fire he -

You see here unnumbered multitudes
will be punished from God, and the
glory; ~~not~~ by his Power, for
commissions of duty as well as the
corruptions of sin. Hence our duty
