Mr. Pitt

I must trouble you some  
 more. In consequence of what  
 passed last session in the House  
 of Lords, on the subject of  
 Ecclesiastical jurisdiction

 next year I have written to the  
 Primate submitting to His  
 Grace the propriety and  
 expediency

expedient of extending by  
law to Colonial Bishops the

their Dioceses, as may be  
conferred on the Bishops in  
England. I have forwarded to
