I must trouble you once
more. In consequence of what
passed last evening in the House
of Lords, on the subject of
Ecclesiastical jurisdiction
and the probability of the
same subject being renewed
next year I have written to the
Premier submitting to his
Grace the propriety and
expediency

law to Colonial Bishops the
same powers and the adoption
of the same forms, for the cure
of spiritual persons within
their Dioceses, as may be
conferred on the Bishops in
