0016 1960's Methodist Church - growing controversy.

Increasing no. of evangelicals unhappy about some church policies. e.g. esp. methodist youth fellowship.

likewise with congregational church (Congregational Youth Fellowship) and presbyterian fellowship - all built on 4 tiered

C - 21st c Physical, intellectual, social, spiritual - plant bearers..

Q 0017 Baptist church - close knit and very traditional

Anglican Church - felt the impact of the evangelicals.

catholic church - remained monolithic until Vatican II.

0014 1970's - general respect in community of the church was decreased (as a result of the 1960's).

Youth work suddenly became a lot harder.

0019 Evangelical influence faltered, because was no robust social dimension of what evangelicals had been doing previously.

0328 Antiauthoritarianism surfaced in students → all this decreased the effects of the church on public life.

0400 Splinter groups - charismatics, pentecostals, set up. Some stayed in the main denominations.

0460 Charismatic groups and traditional evangelicals - some communication/agreement between groups esp. in QLD.

0544 Navigators, Campus Crusade.

0630 Now growth and division (Some activism but not the integrated witness that it was then).

0655 Demise of SCM (Campus groups under SCM).

0715 MRM (moral Rearmament Movement). Kim Beazley Snr was involved.

0775 SCM locally - merged with Newman Society. Then died out.

0906 Brian Hill's own church - 2 different styles of morning congregation are described.

1100 Rod March - minister, IT CAS, people around him

1145 Evangelicals - Strength in Uniting Church in Perth:  
(leadership is weak, residual ideologies from 1100)

1150 (liberal thinking); evangelicals are the one driving force.

1200 Aboriginal rights etc are bringing liberals + evangelicals together.

1235 Steve Francis, George Davies (Youth Consultants)

1266 Youths not concerned with denomination labels →  
more concerned with where the goods are :  
important for evangelical integration in the future.

1270 Cf. Ministries of Scripture Union, AFES were important for  
evangelical integration in the past.

1340 % Strength of evangelicals - Uniting Church in WA has  
probably perhaps a small %, but show steps

1413 Uniting churches which have evangelical pastors -  
very small number now

1471 Uniting church aust. wide: missionary statistics.

1650 Alan Kerr - Now chairman of ZADOC.
