My dear Canon,

I have the pleasure to inform you that you were unanimously and enthusiastically appointed a Delegate from this diocese to the Pan Anglican Congress by the Synod at its late session - I hope you may be able to attend and that I may join you in your delegation -

I thank you very much for your letter about Mr. Inwood - your impression of him is just the impression I formed of him tho' not having seen him - I shall be greatly disappointed if the time chosen for his coming here is filled up with confirmations in far off places - I do not yet know the date of his coming -

With regard to giving him a provisional license, I long for the day when we can do this for all Evangelical ministers of all sorts but I am pretty sure that in doing it in an isolated case would do more harm than good - I hope to be in Sydney this day fortnight for a few days & shall see you and dear Mr. Jones -
