After morning tea had been enjoyed Mrs Brigadier Smartt gave a vivid account of the circumstances in which the Epistle to the Philippians was written. The content of the Epistle was discussed by Mrs Gifford and Mrs Lew.

After a lunch of coffee and sandwiches Mrs Geoffrey Young spoke of the work being done for Asian students in Australia, and of the need for more people to offer hospitality. This was something which might be undertaken by women who were debarred from many types of service because of young children. The students did not wish for elaborate hospitality but to be received into ordinary homes.

The day was very interesting and stimulating and the only regret of those present was that the attendance was so small (about 40).
