

ST. ANDREW'S-TIDE 1942.

Pastoral Letter from the Most Reverend the Archbishop of Sydney to be read in the Churches of the Diocese of Sydney on Sundays November 22 and 29.

Once again I invite all members of the Church in the Diocese of Sydney to observe St. Andrew's-tide as a Day of Prayer for Missions. On the world wide fellowship of the Church rests our greatest hope for the world's future peace and happiness.

On St. Andrew's Day in St. Andrew's Cathedral, I shall (D.V.) celebrate Holy Communion at 10 o'clock and from 11 to 3 there will be special periods of intercession led by representatives of the Australian Board of Missions and the Church Missionary Society. This year there will be a new feature in our Day of Prayer. At 7.45 p.m. I shall lead a United Service of Intercession in the Cathedral in which representatives of all Missionary Societies and organisations associated with the National Missionary Council as well as the China Inland Mission will take part. Because of what the St. Andrew's-tide Day of Prayer for Missions has meant in the past I urge you to spend some definite part of this day in prayer for the world wide responsibilities of the Church.
