Your Grace,

Australian Church Women operates within the Australian Council of Churches, and is a co-ordinating, programme-planning group to help existing women's groups within the various Churches.

This we try to do by encouraging united worship on three special days of the year, viz. The Women's World Day of Prayer, Fellowship Day and World Community Day. For the two latter days Orders of Service are prepared by Australian Church Women.

Also, we encourage service together through the Winifred Kiek Scholarship and the Fellowship of the Least Coin, and sometimes an additional project such as for World Community Day this year the special project was Inter-Church Aid - to help migrant women in Australia.

We enclose copy of our Constitution, and also some literature having to do with Special Days and Projects - for your information.

The main purpose of this letter is to advise you that the annual National Committee Meeting of Australian Church Women will be held at Deaconess House, Carillon Avenue, Newtown, Sydney, on February 8, 9, 10, commencing with Lunch on Wednesday and concluding with Afternoon Tea on the Friday.

We would be very happy if you would appoint one of the ladies of the Russian Orthodox Church to attend this meeting as an observer. If you would be happy to do this, and would let us know the name of the person, then we could make contact with her and let her have further details.

The Thursday night session on February 9, which will be held at Deaconess House will be an open session - for men and women of all Churches - and we would be very glad to welcome members of your Church. We enclose a dozen copies of an invitation letter for this meeting by which you will see that the subject for the meeting will be Communication, and there will be a speaker who is qualified to speak on this subject as well as times for questions, etc.

Australian Church Women, a body affiliated with the Australian Council of Churches, has five main aims -

1. To unite Australian church women in their allegiance to their Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ;
2. To promote co-operation of men and women in the church, family and society;
3. To help Christian women to take a more effective place in the total life and mission of the Church;
4. To provide opportunities for Christian women of different denominations to worship, study and serve together and
5. To encourage fellowship and service across national boundaries.

At the recent National Committee Meeting held in Adelaide and attended by delegates from every State, representing such denominations as Anglican, Catholic, Baptist, Churches of Christ, Congregational, Methodist Presbyterian and Salvation Army, and women's organisations such as the Girls' Brigade and the Y.W.C.A., delegates asked that we look into ways of relating with women from Orthodox Churches.

With this in view, I wrote to Very Rev. Fr. K. Paalios explaining that we would like to make contact with any women's groups of which he knew, either on a national or State level. He has replied by giving us your name and suggesting that we arrange to talk with you.



Following our meeting last month, when we expressed our desire that we might interest the women of the Greek Orthodox Church in our organization, I approached Major G. Stelstra. He has now informed me that through his contact with Father Leonidas that this matter has been gladly approved.

He has given me quite a number of addresses to contact, and it would not be possible for me to contact them all, as by our constitution- "The Council of Australian Church Women shall consist of eight (8) from each participating Church, appointed by the State Women's Organization or by whatever means is appropriate to the particular Church." We would be pleased to welcome your representatives, and a constitution is enclosed for information about our group.

Our meetings are held, for the Council, on the 3rd Monday of Feb. Mar. Apr. June, Aug. Sept. Nov, at 10.30a.m. and next year will be at Uniting Church Offices, 139 Castlereagh St. Sydney. However on Monday 20th February, our first meeting for 1978, we are holding a special Service of Renewal and Dedication in the Pitt St.. Uniting Church at 10.30a.m. with guest speaker Mrs. Lillian Wells, Moderator of the Uniting Church N.S.W. Synod. All visitors are welcome, and perhaps some of the ladies of the Greek Orthodox would care to join us on this day. Hoping you can encourage some to attend, and if it is wished to affiliate with our organization, we would welcome your representatives to our meetings in the future. There will be a business meeting following that service at 12 o'clock.
