WELCOME: In the absence due to illness of Mrs Carmel Keys, Past President Major Lyn Middleton welcomed everyone to the meeting, with particular mention of Lillian Hodges, a new representative to ACW from The Salvation Army, as Joan Tong has stood down.

DEVOTIONS: Lyn Middleton drew attention to how good it is to be on the sunny side of Easter, having again shared the greeting 'He is risen' and the response, 'He is risen indeed'. Tony Campolo told the story of an Afro-American pastor who used the cry 'it's Friday, but Sunday's coming' as the basis of a long sermon. Resurrection day is the heart and soul of Christianity. Through the risen saviour, our living Lord, we see new truths year after year. John Owen, a Puritan stated on his death bed, 'I am yet in the land of the dying, but hope soon to be in the land of the living'.
