Dear Friends,

This is the first issue of THE CHRONICLE for 1991. It comes close to the beginning of Lent.

We live in a society where everybody must be seen as equals and everything must be the same. This surely must be one of the greatest lies that modern educationalists and their theorists have bucketed on our generation. What a boring world it would be if we were all the same. Yet that is what some would have us believe.

I often wonder of what sort of thing lies behind the attitude that many church-goers have towards the various highlights of the Church Year. Let us forget about Ash Wednesday, let us forget about Lent, let us ignore Good Friday (except perhaps that might not be wise after all we get a Public Holiday for it!).

What hypocrisy the world goes on with; wanting all the major Holy Days as Public Holidays but caring nothing for the God in whose honor they are kept.

I see great value in observing these days and seasons. I do not do it just for the sake of tradition but for the things they have to teach me about the christian gospel.

To begin, Ash Wednesday reminds us of the way in which Jesus our Saviour and Lord experienced the sort of temptations that the Evil One directs against us. Tempted we are, and too often we fall to these temptations. Jesus was likewise tempted but without sin. He was able to be victorious and so can we, if we allow Jesus to control our lives and if our strength is placed in Him and not in ourselves.

Ash Wednesday has a lot to teach us about our walk with God. Lessons we need to be reminded of at least every year.

Lent which begins with Ash Wednesday is an excellent preparation for the Easter celebration. It is so easy for Good Friday and Easter to arrive with the long week-end (first one since Australia Day) and to

catch us unprepared. Without the forty days of Lent how is it possible to have even the slightest understanding of the magnitude of what Christ death on the cross achieved? Lent suggests that for forty days we ought to stop and realise that our sin alone was enough to crucify our Lord.

When we get a sense of our own unworthiness before God then the events of Good Friday and Easter Day shine for the in their colours. Then we well might wonder at God's love.

What a pity to be ignorant of such great love. Make time to remember your Lord during this season of Lent so that you too may enjoy the blessings of Easter.

## MY LENTEN "SPIRITUAL CHECK-UP"


1. Have I had a personal experience of Jesus Christ?


