Treasurer's Report

General Business

a. Social Justice

The Victorian Royal Commission on Family Violence released it's report on 30th March.

It recommended many changes to the law and preventative measures. Suitable affordable housing is desperately needed for women and families

Social Justice issues have been in the news constantly – sexual abuse of children, family violence to women and children; inequality in income for women doing the same job as men; student workers being underpaid; bullying of women workers in all types of employment.

One quite startling claim was made by women surgeons who were being harassed by male surgeons for sexual favours if they wished to progress in their work.

Another matter that came to my attention was a training program for schools in Africa called "Wise Choices for Life". It aims to break the poverty cycle by educating young people about their bodies and relationships. It empowers people to make choices about how many children they have. It tells girls they can say 'NO'.

Both projects deserving of support but as Fran is supposed to put them in order she put Asylum Seekers as number 1. The ACT had a project that they were thinking about but she has not had any information from them at this stage.

The N E has also received the draft copy of the World Community Day Service written by W A 'Empowered by the Spirit'. It needs to be 'accepted by NE.

Fran pointed out that in the near future she would need to write to two Units whose turn it is to produce the service for 2017 – asking would it be possible for the two subtitles to be decided upon also as they can be included in the letters that go to SA for Fellowship Day and ACT for World Community Day

No copies of either of these applications had been seen by NE. Phone calls were made to Fran and Anne Kennedy but both were away from home on leave.

The Service needs to be sent on the states. Elaine and Joy to read and be ready asap.

The service needs details of the chosen project on the opening page. The Vic President who prepared the application also away in Greece.
