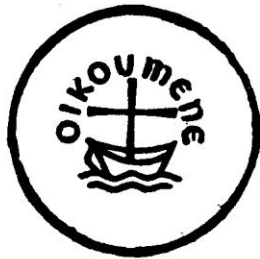


**AUSTRALIAN CHURCH WOMEN**

**Theme:**

*"know, grow, go."*

KNOW, GROW, GO.

Call to Worship:

Leader:

Let me come into the Church of God  
to meet the Spirit of God  
not to give religion an hour  
but to live in the eternal.

Let not mine eyes roam over architecture or  
congregation, nor let my thoughts escape out  
into the world but that they be still and  
know that thou art GOD.

I asked for strength that I might achieve;  
He made me weak that I might obey.  
I asked for health that I might do greater  
things;  
I was given grace that I might do better  
things.  
I asked for riches that I might be happy;  
I was given poverty that I might be wise.  
I asked for power that I might have the praise  
of men;  
I was given weakness that I might feel the  
need of God.  
I asked for all things that I might enjoy life;  
I received nothing that I asked for, all that  
I hoped for. My prayer was answered.

In our time of fellowship today we pray that  
all will feel the presence of God. May we  
KNOW Him better - GROW with Him into Christian  
maturity - then GO hand in hand with Him to  
fulfil His command "GO YE". May each life be  
strengthened through His indwelling Holy  
Spirit to teach us His truths that our GOING  
will bring God the Glory and the extension of  
His Kingdom.

KNOW

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 3:14-19

PRAYER (in unison)

Help us to see the truths about ourselves,  
however bitter those truths may be.

Help us to see our faults and not be over-  
powered by their number. Help us not to be  
discouraged by their gravity.

Lord, give us the sense to see our faults  
and the courage to attack them.

Give us the will to do this, Lord. And the  
strength and the patience to keep on trying even  
when we fail.

Be tolerant of us in this struggle - and help us to be tolerant with ourselves.

We thank you, O God, for the privilege of prayer. You have told us to come boldly for help in times of need. We are needy people, Lord. We are looking to you to supply all our needs even as you have promised in your Word.

These things we ask for Jesus' sake. Amen.

#### HYMN

At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow,  
Every tongue confess him King of Glory now;  
'Tis the Father's pleasure we should call him Lord,  
Who from the beginning was the might Word.

In your hearts enthrone Him; there let Him subdue;

Leader: "A Thought"

SHARING CORNER - Let us share these two questions -

Do we really know God, or do we know OF  
Him?  
Need we have a personal knowledge of Him?

not just professing Christians but possess-  
ing Christians. Let us quieten our hearts  
before Him and seek to answer this question.

Time of silent meditation and prayer.

HYMN (remain seated until verse four whilst offering is taken)
