Since joining Australian Church Women 20 years ago, Eunice has held several positions in Australian Church Women.

State Executive from 1985 until 1992 holding the following executive positions:

Vice President 1985 – 1986; President Elect 1986 – 1987;

Victoria Unit President 1987 – 1988; Past President 1988 – 1989;

Assistant Secretary 1989 – 1991; Fellowship of the Least Coin Representative 1991 – 1993.

Eunice was appointed National President 1993 – 1995 when the National Conference was held in Victoria. She attended the Asian Church Women's Conference Assembly in Jakarta.

IN 1984 – 1985 Eunice was chosen to represent Australian Church Women on a State Committee to make plans for Christian involvement in Victoria's 150th Celebration. She has also been Secretary of the Victorian Committee of World Day of Prayer.

Eunice has been active in her local church and community. She is an elder in her church and is on the Chaplaincy Committee of Croydon High School, where she was influential in the appointment of a Chaplain, as well as other community work.

She was State President of Christian Women's Fellowship [Churches of Christ] in 1982 – 1983 and National President in 1991. Eunice was also Australian Representative to WCCC – Christian Women's Fellowship.

At present Eunice continues to represent the Churches of Christ on the Victoria Council of Churches.

At the National Conference in South Australia in 2001 she was appointed with two other experienced members to be on a 'Referral Committee' which had to deal with a constitutional problem. This shows the regard in which she is held at National Executive level. Eunice has been of great assistance at State and National level when her discernment and consideration of constitutional matters, as well as interpretation, has proved invaluable.

At present Eunice is an Elder of the Church of Christ at Montrose and Seniors' Ministry Convener Pastoral Care.

Eunice has three married children and nine grandchildren. Her interests are wedding sewing , cooking, travel and family.
