

By the Tenor of these Presents, We, *James* <sup>by Divine permission</sup>  
BISHOP OF MANCHESTER, do make it known unto all Men, that on *Sunday* the  
*Twenty fourth* day of *September* in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
*ninety-three* We, the Bishop before mentioned, solemnly administering Holy Orders, under the protection  
of the Almighty, in *the parish Church of Saint Luke Heywood*, in the  
County of Lancaster, within our Diocese, DID ADMIT our beloved in Christ *Stephen Taylor*  
*B.A. of Corpus Christi College Cambridge*

(of whose virtuous and pious life and Conversation, and competent learning and knowledge in the Holy Scriptures,  
We were well assured) into the holy order of **Deacons**, according to the manner and form prescribed and  
used by the Church of England; and him the said *Stephen Taylor*  
did then and there rightly and canonically ordain **Deacon**, he having first in our presence made and subscribed  
the Declaration of Assent, and taken and subscribed the Oath of Allegiance provided to be made, subscribed, and  
taken by "The Clerical Subscription Act, 1865" and the "Promissory Oaths Act, 1868" **In Testimony**  
whereof We have caused our Episcopal Seal to be hereunto affixed the day and year above written, and in the  
*Eighth* year of our *Translation*
