Beyond the Parish Barbara was an office bearer of Catholic Women's League at Diocesan, State and National Levels. She was also a delegate to Australian Church Women and has been Vice-President and President of the Unit, and served as Publications Officer in the 1987-89 West Australian based National Committee, and Vice President when we last served this office in 2001-03. Poor health curtailed her time with us and we have missed her over the past several years.

Barbara died on 2 June 2013, and we were sorry that only a few of our members were able to attend her Memorial Service. Her husband predeceased her in 1999. She was very proud of her children and grandchildren.

Her hobbies were music, art, reading and travel.
