The light shines in the darkness for those who are merciful, kind and just.

Australian Church Women Inc came into being in 1965 when Women's Inter-church Councils from all states and territories came together to form a group to foster ecumenism and undertake action on behalf of Church women. Australian Church Women Inc now forms a network of committed Christian women, dedicated to encourage fellowship and service across denominational, national and international boundaries.

Fellowship of the Least Coin encourages everyone to pray for justice and reconciliation and offer their least coin as a token of prayer. Monies collected during each year are brought to World Community Day Services by groups and individuals, and are dedicated. These funds are then sent to State/Territory Treasurers who forward them to the National Treasurer of ACW Inc who in turn sends the funds to International Committee of the Least Coin (IFLC) where up to 50 grants are given to programs, supporting and encouraging women in particular, in all regions of the world.

The Special Day Project for 2011 is the Red Cap Anger Management/Breakfast Clubs run by the Salvation Army in various primary schools in the ACT. The Breakfast club provides a healthy breakfast for children (and sometimes teachers) who for various reasons arrive at school without having eaten. Red Cap is an early intervention anger management program for primary school children. The children are identified as needing assistance to deal appropriately with their emotional responses in stressful situations. The program teaches children to identify their emotions and develop skills to recognise their anger triggers and deal with their feelings in a positive manner.

The General Offering from this service will be divided between Asian Church Women's Conference, with which ACW Inc is affiliated and supports annually, and the 2011 Special Day Project.
