Elaine is working on an application for a trust.

2. **Treasurer.** Margaret Watson presented the Financial Statement, 1 December 2005 to 30 June 2006. A cheque for \$823 has been sent to assist Myanmar and Cambodia and an email expressing thanks for this donation has been received.

3. **Winifred Keik Scholarship Convener.** Una Birtchnell reported that she had received a letter of thanks for cards from E. Kinrade. L. Adam has \$18.

4. **Fellowship of the Least Coin Convener.** Lola Adam reported that she has no further news of reception of grant applications. Esther has sent 500 FLC brochures on request.

5. **ACWC.** B. Lacy read Pat Walker’s report. National reports are being collected from each country to be included in the General Assembly book. President Annam has paid a deposit to the hotel where we will be staying and has had new ACWC badges made. The March-June copy of ACWC has details of our speakers for the Assembly. Our prayers are needed for our Indonesian sisters and our sisters in Nepal.

6. **Publication Editor.** Donna Bryan needs articles from the State Units for ACW News.

7. **Special Days.** Beth Skilbeck needs the FD Order of Service from WA Unit by the end of September.

8. **Australian Women’s Coalition.** Anne Murray reported that a submission has been sent to the Annual Report for AWC and a photo has been sent for the Calendar. Anne attended the Women Together Conference on 10 August. Issues included Domestic Violence, Migrant women and Leadership of women. The Second Key issues Consultation Project Proposal will study the impact of Life/Work/Family balance issues on women’s health and vice versa. 19 member organizations of AWC will distribute a survey to 60 women within 3 age brackets. Anne will distribute 60 surveys to the State/Territory Units by 1 September and they are to be returned by 29 September.
