

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF HOSTEL COMMITTEE AND EXECUTIVE
OF N.S.W. WOMEN'S INTER-CHURCH COUNCIL, ON THURSDAY, 24th.

MAY, 1962.

Mrs. Millar, in chair, called upon Mrs. Lew to open the meeting with prayer.

PRESENT: Mesdames: Lew, Baker, Pearson and Lilly, representing WICC, and Mesdames: Millar, Hall, Paterson, Paton, Deane, Palmer, Stolz, Thode and Knight representing Hostel Committee, (Mrs. Walker).

An apology was received from Miss Roseby.

Mrs. Millar read a letter sent to her from the Secretary which contained some suggestions for improving the Hostel and which was the reason for calling this meeting.

After inspecting the bedrooms it was decided to leave them in their present state for the time being.

In order to fill the vacancies Mrs. Lew suggested that we take High School girls from Asian Countries. These children would be from 12 years of age. The Committee decided to take children should the occasion arise.

Mrs. Verco advised there was a need for accommodation for post-graduate students from Asian Countries. These are older women, but would settle into Hostel life. Their period of residence would only be in the vicinity of six months.

A good second hand washing machine has been offered to the Hostel at the low figure of £15. This, together with a good second hand gas copper will be installed shortly. Moved by Mrs. Lew and seconded by Mrs. Pearson that washing machine be purchased. The copper was decided upon at a previous meeting.

Mrs. Millar presented Miss Roseby's Annual Financial Statement. Mrs. Walker moved that it be received. Mrs. Millar did some costing, on a 40 week basis and found the expenditure is slightly higher than the receipts. This, no doubt, has been caused by the vacancies that have occurred.

A letter was received from Miss Roseby intimating her desire to relinquish the office of Treasurer of the Hostel Committee. This was received with much regret as Miss Roseby has done a wonderful work in this field since the inception of the Hostel. The Secretary was instructed, therefore, to write and ask Mr. Hall if he would consider taking charge of the books. The Secretary was instructed to write to Miss Roseby to thank her for all she has done for "Wybalena"

The meeting was closed by Mrs. Millar who pronounced the Benediction.
